

## Instrument Maintenance Tips

How to take care of your Juma Instrument(s):

- 1. Do not leave the instrument in wetness, rain or direct heat/sunlight because it can damage the instrument.
- 2. Regularly put a little bit of petroleum jelly (like vaseline) on the metal keys especially on the tips. It gives more playing comfort and slows down any rust.
- 3. Handle the instrument carefully as dropping or bumping may move the keys and affect the tuning.
- 4. How to adjust keys that have moved out of position: put a flat screwdriver at the top on the side of the key where it is touching and with a small hammer tap the back of the screwdriver gently until the keys are apart.
